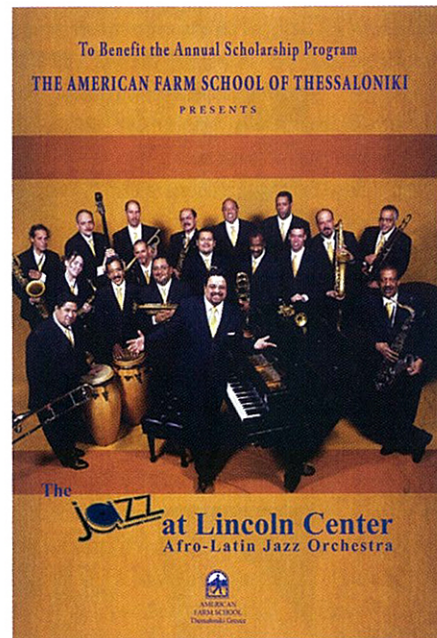

The American Farm School is an independent, nonprofit educational institution founded in 1904 to serve the rural population of Greece and the Balkans. Major educational divisions include the High School, the Dimitris Perrotis College of Agricultural Studies and the department of Lifelong Learning.

by the large-scale Demonstration and Teaching Farm that includes one of the most important Holstein dairy herds in Greece; a poultry unit using the latest scientific methods for Omega-3 and other egg, broiler and turkey production; greenhouses; vegetable gardens; vineyard and winery; olive trees; and extensive field crops.
