

General Information about Summer on the Farm

Session dates:

Session I: 16 June – 26 June (& Sat. 20 June)

Session II: 29 June – 10 July

Session III: 24 August – 4 September

Duration of each session:

Two weeks per session, Monday through Friday

Included Services:

- ❖ **Meals** (full breakfast and lunch) at the AFS dining room
- ❖ **Transportation** from and to all parts of the city, with a bus escort
- ❖ **Insurance coverage** for the children (European Reliance)
- ❖ **Doctor** available on campus

For children
aged 4 - 14

Teams:

Children are grouped based on their age. Each team is staffed by one Group Leader and two Assistants.

The program:

The program is roughly designed in 2 age groups:

Group 1: Pre-K & Kindergarten AND **Grades 1 – 4**

Group 2: Grades 5 – 6 AND **Middle School**

All the activities follow an experiential approach and take place outdoors—provided that conditions allow it. Children in group 2 have the opportunity to practice their English language skills as well since one assistant in the group always speaks in English.

Additionally there is a parallel program, entirely in English, for children older than 3rd grade (please see separate document).

One sleepover per session is offered for children in Grades 4–9.

Cost per child and payment:

- €390 *with* transportation fees OR €410 for the English program
- €340 *without* transportation OR €360 for the English program
- €55 for one sleepover per child (optional)

Discounts:

- 10% discount for the second child and 15% for the third child of the same family.
- 10% discount for participating again in a second session.
** Only one of these two discounts will be applied **
- In case of a group registration for 10 children or more, there is a 15% discount on the overall cost for all children in the group. There is no discount on the transportation cost.

In all cases **2 full meals** will be provided.

- A deposit of €200 is required with registration. Full payment is due 1 week before the session begins. Payments are made either at the school's bursar or by direct deposit at one of the following bank accounts:
