This program is ideal for:

- Children aged 9 and above who know how to communicate in basic English.
- Children who have studied English in school or privately, but don't feel comfortable speaking English yet. We make immersion fun—it is all on the tip of their tongues waiting to come out!

The Application Process

Step 1: Complete the application by **May 25**.

Step 2: On a designated date, attend our orientation day on campus for our team to meet the participants and determine the appropriate group for your child. There, children will be placed in small groups to play games or make crafts (all in English).

Step 3: We will inform all participants about which group we think they would feel most comfortable in: English or Greek.

All children will have fun and make friends, no matter the language they are using!

Ages

Children that have completed Grade 3 and higher are eligible for our English-track program.

Summer Camp Dates & Schedule

Session I: June 16–26, 2020 (also June 20)

Session II: June 29– July 10, 2020

Session III: August 24–September 4, 2020

Hours of the camp's operation are 8:00a.m. – 4:00p.m.

Cost

The cost of the English *Summer on the Farm* for each session is 410 euros, including transportation and 2 meals.
